WELSH LANGUAGE CONSULTATIVE GROUP TERMS OF REFERENCE

As from 1 January 2010

1. SUMMARY OF PURPOSE

The purpose of the Welsh Language Consultative Group is to be available to the clerks, the administrator and publications committee to offer advice about Welsh language texts, on behalf of Meeting of Friends in Wales.

2. MEMBERSHIP

- 2.1 Welsh Language Consultative Group will have three to six members, spread geographically through Wales, appointed triennially on a rolling programme by Meeting of Friends in Wales. Each member is appointed for an initial term of three years, but could be invited to serve for a second or third term.

3. FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS

- 3.1 The Group will not normally meet, but will carry out much of its work by email and telephone conferencing.

4. TASKS

- 4.1 Members of the group will be available to support work through the Welsh language, particularly in advising Britain Yearly Meeting in relation to matters relating to the Welsh language.

5. AUTHORITY & ACCOUNTABILITY

- 5.1 The Group is accountable to Meeting of Friends in Wales and shall act according to the general guidance agreed in minute 09.34 of the meeting held on 24.10.09
